

# Key Stage 4 Curriculum Overview

At the end of year 9 students will have the option to choose from a range of subjects that will enable them to profit from a holistic education. The compulsory subjects are Mathematics, English language (first or second language) and Science. However, the level of challenge delivered will be tailored to match the ability of the specific student. From 2018/2019, Mathematics will offer an accelerated mathematics course which will cover the Mathematics iGCSE curriculum in year 10 and progress onto the Further Pure Mathematics curriculum in year 11, preparing students who wish to pursue mathematics in Year 12. English Literature will be offered to students that are taking English first language and Science will deliver the single, double and triple award in year 10 and 11. Students will then have the option to pick subjects from modern foreign languages, humanities and art, technology and enterprise. Physical Education is mandatory for all students until the end of year 11 but will not be offered as an option in 2018/2019. In 2019/2020 we will be expanding on the options currently on offer, broadening the curriculum to allow students to develop into well-equipped young adults.
